Our working rare breeds' farm is a major activity on site. It provides the opportunity to learn how to care for animals while working as part of a team. Barrington Farm offers 20 acres of paddocks and lawns. As well as the working farm, we offer large areas and pathways which are great for walks and games. On warmer days people who use our service can enjoy use of the BBQ, picnic area and a variety of outdoor seating.
